



Clouser Minnow

Bob Clouser

Choose a hook size to suit where fishing is to take place.

Method

- Tie in thread one third from the hook eye, make wraps and apply super glue.
- Place dumbbell eyes and secure with figure-eight wraps.
- Bring the thread behind the eyes and tie in a few strands of flash material.
- Bring thread forward over the eyes. Select a sparse amount of bucktail and tie in, bring back over the eyes and secure about to the bend of the hook, keeping the material on top of the hook.
- Bring the thread forward in front of the eyes.
- Turn the fly or the vice upside down and tie in more bucktail same as on the top. You can make this slightly more. Do not take your thread back past the eyes.
- Whip finish the head and coat with head cement or UV.

This pattern should be tied sparsely. Do not be afraid to use plenty of glue to secure your eyes onto the hook.
