

Han's Midge Nymph



A great fly for nymphing in summer, used on a dropper line just below the surface with an indicator and a second weighted nymph at the point.

Materials

Hook: black magic B14, but better still a black magic G14

Vinyl rib, black or dark brown.

White egg yarn.

Peacock herl.

Black thread.

Method

Tie on thread till just past the curve of the hook and bring it back to approx. 4 mm in front of the eye of the hook.

Tie in on that spot some white egg yarn using figure of eight.

Trim to approx 20 mm.

Tie in strip of vinyl behind the egg yarn and tie down to just past the bend of the hook.

Bring back thread forward and make a half hitch.

Bring the vinyl forward in touching turns till the egg yarn. Tie off.

Tie in peacock herl behind the egg yarn and wrap around the thread to reinforce.

Wind herl behind and in front of the egg yarn to form the thorax and tie off whip finish.

Cut off the white egg yarn short to only show a little white "wing case".
