



Mrs Simpson Killer Pattern

1. Glue to the top of the hook.
2. Lay thread from the front of the hook leave a good space behind the eye.
3. Tie in the tail the length of the hook (squirrel tail) or similar.
4. Tie in the body red wool, bring forward in touching turns (leave plenty of room at the head).
5. Build a tapered head.
6. Select two wings for each side of the fly, strip off the fluff, do not cut at this stage.
7. Pull forward with the stems you didn't cut then cut stems off.
8. Tie in loosely and adjust until in the correct position pull forward to lay the feathers on the side of the body.
9. Build up a head to finish the fly.
